





GUIDELINES FOR ENGAGEMENT OF SUPPORT STAFFS FOR THE BOYS HOSTEL

General Condition for Engagement

The candidate (i) must be a permanent resident of Deogarh district of Odisha, (ii) Must have passed ME standard in Odia Language, (iii) Must not be having more than one spouse living, (iv) Must furnish no objection certificate from the employer, if he is in service (v) Must be a male.

All the posts are purely contractual and can be terminated at any time.

1. Warden: (One)

- Male.
- Qualification: B.A/B.Sc from any recognized University.
- He has to stay in the hostel 24 x 7
- Age: 30-60 Years as on the date of advertisement.
- Experience: At least 02 years in hostel management.
- Remuneration: Rs. 21,175/-per month (including EPF share of Employee & Employer)

i. The preference shall be given to the local candidate.

ii. If any in-service teacher of OAV is willing to discharge the duties of a warden in addition to his duties, he may be paid monthly remuneration of Rs. 3000/- in addition to his own salary. But he must have to stay in the hostel even during the night hours and have to take all responsibilities.

iii. Retired teachers, if willing and physically & mentally sound within the age limit of 62 years as on the date of the engagement, may be engaged as Warden.

2. Chowkidar-cum-Sweeper (One)

- Male
- Remuneration: Rs. 7,500/- per month (including EPF share of Employee & Employer)
- Age: 21 to 32 years as on the date of advertisement.
- Qualification: He must have passed HSC Examination.
- The preference shall be given to the local candidate.

3. Head Cook (One)

- Male
- He has to stay in the hostel 24 x 7
- Remuneration: Rs. 9,000/- per month (including EPF share of Employee & Employer)
- Age: 30 to 40 years as on the date of advertisement

- Qualification: He must have passed HSC Examination
- If somebody is trained in cookery, he will be given preference & due weightage.
- The preference shall be given to the local candidate.
- Cook himself be perfectly hygienic in his dresses, cooking habits etc.
- The committee staff conduct physical cooking of some items & evaluate the deliciousness/ consumption of time for preparation if the dishes/ hygienic condition of cooking & select the best.
- The cook must be well conversant to use LPG.

4. Assistant Cook (Two)

- Male.
- He has to stay in the hostel 24X7.
- Remuneration: Rs. 6750/- per month (including EPF share of Employee & Employer).
- Age: 21 to 32 years as on the date of advertisement.
- Qualification: He must have passed HSC Examination
- Maximum 02 number of Assistant Cooks can be engaged in one Hostel.
- Having experience in cooking and other characteristics as specified above in 3.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF DIFFERENT STAKE HOLDERS FOR SMOOTH OPERATIONALISATION OF HOSTELS

Warden

1. A monthly food ministry will be formed from among the boarders comprising of five members (three from Senior and two from junior classes). Warden has to coordinate with the members of the food ministry in order to ensure quality of food. Every month, the ministry will be changed with new members.
2. The warden will issue the materials for cooking in presence of the food ministry and maintain the consumption register.
3. Warden will take the attendance of boarders twice a day i.e. 5:30 AM & 5:30 PM.
4. In each week the warden and superintendent will verify and certify the stock.
5. To ensure safety and security of the boarders of the hostel.
6. To ensure proper functioning of all electrical appliances/ water fittings etc.
7. Apart from the above-mentioned duties, he will have to take up other works as directed by Principal and Superintendent.

Head Cook/ Assistant Cook

1. Cook will prepare the food as per the menu fixed by the district committee.
2. Cook, Assistant cook will keep the dining place and kitchen neat and clean.
3. While preparing the cooking items, the quality of items shall be examined by the warden and the cook/ Assistant cook.
4. Fresh & green vegetables must be used.
5. After proper cleaning of the vegetables in fresh water by cook and Asst. cook it will be used for cooking.
6. The cooked food shall not be kept open.
7. Stale food shall not be kept for further use.

8. The boarders shall wash their hands before taking meal, clean the tray and keep in specified place before leaving the dining hall after taking the meal. This work will be monitored by the Head cook and Assistant cooks
9. Apart from the above-mentioned duties, he will have to take up other works as directed by Principal and Warden.

Chowkidar-Cum-Sweeper

1. He will clean the hostel room with phenyl once every day
2. He will clean the toilets and bathrooms twice every day with phenyl
3. He will ensure security of the hostel/ properties of the hostel/ safety of inmates.
4. He will ensure that, the corridor lights are kept on for the safety of the hostel students.
5. He will accompany the warden if required for taking students to hospital during sickness.
6. Apart from the above-mentioned duties, he will have to take up other works as directed by Principal and Warden.
